		Follow up assessment 22/09/21: There is an established engagement system to respect the rights of Indigenous Peoples. FPIC is not required as this is not a new mine (Bingham Copper Mine has been in operations since 1906) and the site has not received any claim related to the Utah land. Instead, there are processes to avoid adverse impacts on Indigenous Peoples' lands, livelihoods, resources, and cultural heritage. There is a documented stakeholder' engagement plan, which covers indigenous people.
		This was confirmed through a review of research, risk identification, and processes to engage stakeholders including the Speak Up grievance mechanism.
